

**2022-2023 WYLIE I.S.D.**  
**NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT INFORMATION**

New student enrollment for the upcoming 2022-2023 school year will be online. We will start processing the applications on the dates listed below:

**Pre-K Registration** –on *Thursday, May 5, 2022* for students entering pre-k. **(\*This is a qualifying program. See website for details. Must be 4 years old by September 1<sup>st</sup>)**

**Kindergarten Roundup** – on *Thursday, May 12, 2022* for students entering kindergarten. **(\*Must be 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup>)**

**All Grades** – on *Thursday, May 19, 2022* for *all new students*.

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- Complete the enrollment forms online at [wyliebulldogs.org](http://wyliebulldogs.org). Click on the “Enrollment” tab, then “New Students”, and then “Begin Online Enrollment”. You will follow the prompts to complete the application.
  - Once the application is submitted, please be watching your email for a computer-generated confirmation email. You will receive this email once the application is processed.

***\*\*If you already have students enrolled at Wylie ISD and need to enroll a new student, you will open Family Access and click on “New Student Enrollment” at the top of the left side bar.***

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**REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION TO UPLOAD IN STEP 5:**

- **PROOF OF RESIDENCY**—MUST be a resident in the Wylie School District. Must provide a current Gas, Water, Electric Bill *in parent/guardian’s name*, **OR** Builder’s Contract if construction is completed in less than 120 days from date of enrollment. If you do not have a utility bill yet, contact one of your providers to request a “proof of service.” If you have any questions regarding Proof of Residency, please call the Administration office at (325)692-4353.
- **SHOT RECORD**--a student who has never attended school before or is transferring from out of state cannot be enrolled until an immunization record is provided.
- **SOCIAL SECURITY CARD**
- **BIRTH CERTIFICATE**
- **PARENT/GUARDIAN DRIVER’S LICENSE**
- **PROOF OF INCOME**—***ONLY*** for those qualifying for Pre-K as “Educationally Disadvantaged” (which means they are eligible to participate in the National Free and Reduced Lunch Program)
- **PREVIOUS SCHOOL RECORDS** (If available)
